FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Over the past year, God has been stirring something beautiful in

our church family. Many of you will remember our "Tree of Dreams"—that powerful season when we prayerfully wrote down our hopes for Bullard Methodist Church and hung them on paper leaves in Harper Hall. Some of those dreams have already blossomed into reality in small but meaningful ways. But many of the biggest dreams remain before us—dreams that are bold, transformational, and filled with Kingdom potential.

This fall, we are stepping into an exciting new season of discernment. Together, we are asking: *Is now the time to take hold of these larger dreams?* To help us explore this, we have entered the **pre-campaign exploratory phase** of a possible capital campaign. We've invited Daniel Dennison, a consultant with Horizons Stewardship, to walk alongside us in this process. Daniel brings a wealth of experience, having helped many churches like ours discover and pursue God's vision for their future.

At the end of August, Daniel began meeting with small groups of people from across our congregation to listen, ask questions, and hear your feedback on the initial vision. In the weeks ahead, he will continue these conversations in various ways, gathering even more input to help us discern what God is calling us to do next.

And then comes an important moment for us all: on **Sunday, October 12, at 10:00 AM** (during the Sunday School hour), our whole church family will gather in the Sanctuary for a **Town Hall Meeting**. This will be our opportunity to come together, hear more about the vision, share openly, and look ahead with faith to what God may be preparing to do through us.

I believe with all my heart that the same God who planted these dreams in us is faithful to bring them to life. This is more than a campaign—it's a journey of faith, hope, and trust in the Spirit's leading. I cannot wait to see how God will move among us as we take these next steps together.

Let's dream boldly. Let's trust deeply. And let's walk forward in faith—because the best is yet to come.

If you have a close friend or relative who lives out of town, you may request a quilt, and we will give it to you to forward it to its final destination. 
