### **PRAYER QUILT MINISTRY**

The Prayer Quilt Ministry will now be meeting on the *first* Thursday of the month. In December, this will be on **December 4, at 9:00 am, in the FLC**. We will pray for the recipients of the quilts at 11:45 a.m. At our December meeting, we will photograph completed quilts, pray, and learn to make Christmas ornaments made with fabric scraps, pins, and styrofoam.

In 2025, we distributed 133 quilts. Twenty-five were given out during a recent mission trip to Baldwin, LA. Fifteen were distributed at Bluebonnet Nursing Home in Bullard following the communion service. Since the ministry began, between February 25, 2024, and November 11, 2025, we have distributed **257** quilts. We distribute to those in the military, with health issues or going through a rough time. We depend on feedback from all of you to know who may be in need of prayers for healing and a quilt for comfort. If you have a close friend or relative who lives out of town, you may request a quilt, and we will give it to you to forward it to its final destination. If you would like a service member to receive a patriotic-themed quilt or an alternative color, please contact us.




