



GETTING TO KNOW YOU



A series where we get to know our church staff. This month, we're highlighting Robert Boren.

What is your role at Bullard Methodist Church, and what do you love most about it?

Director of Traditional Music. I'm grateful for how vibrant and intergenerational our worship life is. It's a joy to see children active in the Traditional Service and many long-time members engaged in Contemporary—our community truly spans every stage of the faith journey.

How did God lead you into ministry or to serve in your current role?

I fell in love with worship as a small child—especially the music. At twelve, I sensed a clear call to serve God through music ministry. Through high school and college, I stayed around the church, but I wasn't yet living fully into that calling. That began to change when I became a fellowship student at FUMC Nacogdoches. There, the Spirit nudged me to honor the promise I'd made as a kid. I started assisting the director, subbing when he was out of town, and discovering the quiet joy of simply showing up to serve.

While I was working on my master's at SFA, Dr. King forwarded a note from Pastor Brasher about a music minister opening at Bullard Methodist Church and encouraged me to apply—"good experience," he said. I had no idea that nearly ten years later I'd still be here, grateful and amazed to call this church home.

In that time, I've watched our congregation dream and build together through the Dream Campaign, helped launch our Contemporary Service (now led by my best friend—soon to be our associate pastor), walked with you through our transition into the Global Methodist Church, and, yes, seen more than a few sound boards replaced along the way.

Through it all, I've witnessed a church that loves to worship—vibrant, faithful, and intergenerational.

I'm thankful every day to serve alongside you. What a gift it is to make music with this family and to see God's faithfulness, year after year.

What's a Scripture verse that has shaped your life or ministry?

Colossians 3:16.

If you could have dinner with any biblical character (besides Jesus), who would it be and why?

Shamgar, for sure. I love how even a minor character in the Bible does something extraordinary—like defeating 600 Philistines with a pointed stick. It's a powerful reminder that faithfulness in ordinary people can lead to extraordinary things.

What's something people might be surprised to learn about you?

I love making origami. I have quite a few little hobbies and quirks, but I'm not sure which one would surprise people the most.

When you're not serving at the church, what's your favorite way to spend a day off?

Surrounded by my three handsome sons and my beautiful wife. "Surrounded" might not be the right word—dogpile is probably more accurate.

What's your favorite worship song or hymn right now?

It Is Well. I'm really enjoying it right now.

What's a hidden talent or quirky skill you have that most people don't know about?

I don't really have one outside of music. One-trick pony, I guess!

What's your go-to comfort food or favorite local restaurant in Bullard/Tyler?

Jucy's is great! I love all their options.

What's one thing you hope people experience when they come to Bullard Methodist Church?

I hope they experience the transformational love of Jesus Christ through every facet of worship—and, more importantly, through our congregation.

METHODIST MEN



PRAYER QUILT MINISTRY

The Prayer Quilt Ministry will be meeting on the second Thursday of January due to the New Year holiday. This will be **January 8, at 9:00 a.m. in the FLC**. We will pray for the recipients of the quilts at 1:45 a.m. At our December meeting, we photographed completed quilts, prayed, and learned to make Christmas ornaments with fabric scraps, pins, and Styrofoam.

In 2025, we distributed 151 quilts. Twenty-five were given out during a mission trip to Baldwin, LA. Fifteen were distributed at Bluebonnet Nursing Home in Bullard following the communion service. Since the ministry began, between February 25, 2024, and December 11, 2025, we have distributed 275 quilts. We distribute to those in the military, with health issues, or going through a rough time. We depend on feedback from all of you to know who may be in need of prayers for healing and a quilt for comfort. If you have a close friend or relative who lives out of town, you may request a quilt, and we will give it to you to forward it to its final destination. If you would like a service member to receive a patriotic-themed quilt, or an alternative color, please contact us.
